Williams Architects Contract

Dohlman reported that the contract for the feasibility study has been fully executed with the city. It was agreed that from here forward Saxen would be the PLAY contact person for all communication with Williams and that Dohlman would be his back up.

Kickoff Meeting With Williams

Discussion was held on having a kickoff meeting with Williams to kickoff the feasibility study sometime in latter January. Saxen will talk with Williams and arrange that date. There was discussion about who should be invited to the kickoff meeting and suggestions were made. A list will be compiled. Discussion was held on the format for the kickoff meeting.

Fund Raising

Saxen reported that the Van Meter Industrial Corp. had contributed \$1,000 to fund the feasibility study and that \$1,600 had been contributed by individual members of the PLAY committee bringing PLAY's total amount raised to \$42,600 toward a goal of \$60,000. Other contacts for funds were discussed.

Soccer Feasibility Study

It was reported by Voss that the Cedar Rapids Soccer Association has completed a feasibility study regarding the sport of soccer in the city and its future. It was suggested that a representative of the Association be invited to a January PLAY meeting to exchange information.

PLAY Logo

Discussion was held on who should be allowed the use of the PLAY logo for letter writing communication. A motion was made by Saxen and seconded by Day that communication with the logo for PLAY be coordinated by a PLAY committee member designated by the PLAY committee. Motion passed. Harrington volunteered to be that committee member.

Next Meeting

The next meeting will be on the regularly scheduled fourth Thursday of the month on Thursday, Dec. 27<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 A.M. at Ambroz. It was felt that a meeting during holiday week was necessary to begin planning preparations for the Kickoff Meeting.
